

# National Application Form

to conduct research in schools in more than one state or territory in Australia

Schooling systems across Australia welcome research in schools that is of high quality, consistent with the provisions of the National Statement on Ethical Conduct in Human Research, which meets additional guidelines for research conducted in or through schools or other educational sites.

Researchers wishing to undertake research in more than one State or Territory complete a single national application form and apply separately to each jurisdiction.

Each jurisdiction in Australia assesses applications to conduct research in its sites according to their own research approval guidelines, although they apply broadly similar criteria.
